All the District Educational Officers and Project Officers of Rajiv Vidya Mission(SSA) in the state are aware that all the Private Unaided Schools shall admit 25% children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in Class-I every year till the completion of Elementary Education.

Further, they are informed that, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its judgement dated:12.04.2012 have upheld the provision of 25% admission of children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in Class-I in all Private Un-aided Schools in RTE Act.

In accordance with the Judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Government have constituted a committee under the Chairmanship of the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad to finalize the modalities for providing of 25% admissions to the children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in Class-I in all Private Un-aided Schools.

The neighbourhood in respect of Primary School is indicated as one Kilometre as per Rule 5 of G.O.Ms.No.20, School Education (PE.Prog.I) Department, dated:03.03.2011.

Therefore, all the District Educational Officers and Project Officers of Rajiv Vidya Mission(SSA) are requested to obtain the neighbourhood for all the private unaided non minority schools (i.e., 1 Km. walking distance) from all Mandal Educational Officers and furnish the details in the format enclosed. They are also requested to cross check neighbourhood with the help of the Geographic Information System(GIS).

The details shall reach the State Project Office, Rajiv Vidya Mission(SSA), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad on or before 18.05.2012 without fail as the academic year is fast approaching.

This may be treated as "IMMEDIATE".
